


Austria lists access to health as one of its priorities for development aid(1) but does not specifically refer to RMNCH or FP in its policy statements. It considers gender equality a cross-cutting issue. (2) Over the previous 3 years a declining trend in Austria's RMNCH and FP funding took place, which however resulted in a sharp increase in Austria's 2016 commitments compared to 2015, with a more moderate increase in disbursements




